The Illinois House and Senate Chambers are located in the 130 year old Illinois State Capitol building in Springfield, Illinois. After years of wear and some questionable remodeling efforts dating back to the 1970's, a decision was made to bring the original Second Empire glory back to the facility. Replacing the aging sound and A/V systems with state of the art functionality was part of this significant effort. The new system includes hundreds of microphones, two massive DSP matrices, new video and speaker systems, seamless IT interface, feeds for broadcasters and live internet streaming.

Integration of the technology into the historic architecture included several unique challenges. Line-array speakers were chosen, not only to provide significant vertical coverage control, but also to provide a vertical visual presence that would help the speaker blend into the background. Custom 34" gooseneck microphones were needed, because the mics are mounted to the low desk tops and need to reach the mouth height of the legislators when standing. The facility's IT department provided voting system touch screens that send network based commands to control the A/V system.
